



## FOSTER CUNNINGHAM FUND

The Cunningham Fund was established in the memory of Foster S. Cunningham, AB '54, MBA '55, who died unexpectedly in 1978, and provides a subsidy for study trips in emerging markets.

The Foster Cunningham fund for study trips is intended to encourage students to attend the official study trips at the school, selected students will vary, based on the fund. Unfortunately these funds are not compatible with any other funds. Funds are awarded based on merit and need. The fund provides from \$1,000 to \$1,500 towards study trips. A Fellow can only receive one Cunningham award during his or her study.

To apply for the Foster Cunningham fund please submit all the requested information through the link for application to be provided on the website when the application is announced to EMI Fellows. The criteria considered for the compensation are:

- be an EMI fellow
- Notes on the relevance of the trip to your academic and career goals
- the basis of your need or a description of your financial status, to
- include a list of grants, awards, financial fellowships, or loans you have
- already received at Johnson or expect to receive and
- your academic and EMI fellowship performance

You will receive a response to your questions two weeks after you submit your application. As we have a limited number of funds we are not able to award funding for all of the applicants.

If you are awarded funding for your internship or case competition you will need to submit:

1. 600-800 word essay/article about your experience in the competition or internship,
2. photos taken during trip, and
3. detailed receipts, with a description of purchase, up to the amount awarded

All funds will be awarded as a reimbursement after all the above items have been submitted.
